

NOTICE OF REGISTRATION FOR THE SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 2, 2021

To the qualified electors of **TEKONSHA COMMUNITY SCHOOLS**
in the Counties of Calhoun and Branch, State of Michigan:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that any qualified elector of Calhoun County in the Tekonsha Community Schools district who is not already registered, may register to vote at the office of their Township Clerk, the office of the County Clerk, a Secretary of State branch office or other designated state agency; or may use the Online Voter Registration System at www.Michigan.gov/vote. Voters who are already registered may update their registration at www.expressSOS.com.

The last day to register in any manner other than in-person with the local clerk is **MONDAY, OCTOBER 18, 2021**.

After October 18, 2021 anyone who qualifies as an elector may register to vote in-person with proof of residency (MCL 168.492) at their Township Clerk's office at the following times: (NOTE: **due to the current pandemic, to reduce the spread of COVID-19, and to protect the safety of the public and staff, local government offices may not be open, or be open on a limited basis. It is advisable to contact the office prior to your visit.**) All offices will be open Election Day from 7:00a until 8:00p.
